

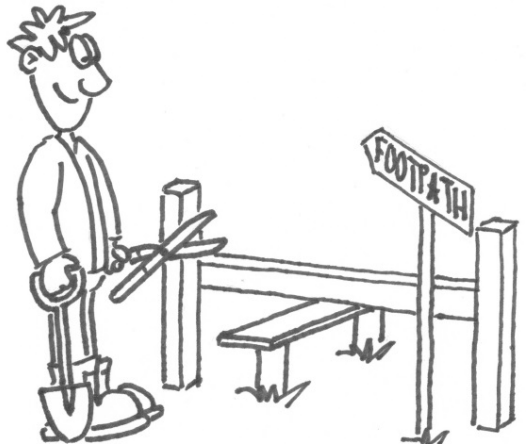
Next time you are out for a walk in South Derbyshire how would you like to find your path blocked by undergrowth and fallen trees, or the stiles broken and difficult to cross?

We need volunteers to walk paths in South Derbyshire and report problems. We already have volunteers walking paths but we need more to cover the whole of South Derbyshire. Unless problems are reported no actions can be taken to rectify the problem.



We also need volunteers to set up a Footpath Working Group.

This Working Group would carry out practical work under the guidance of Derbyshire County Council Rights of Way Team and the Countryside Service to keep the footpath network in South Derbyshire clear and improve its attraction to walkers. Practical work would mainly involve clearing paths and installing and repairing stiles and gates.
